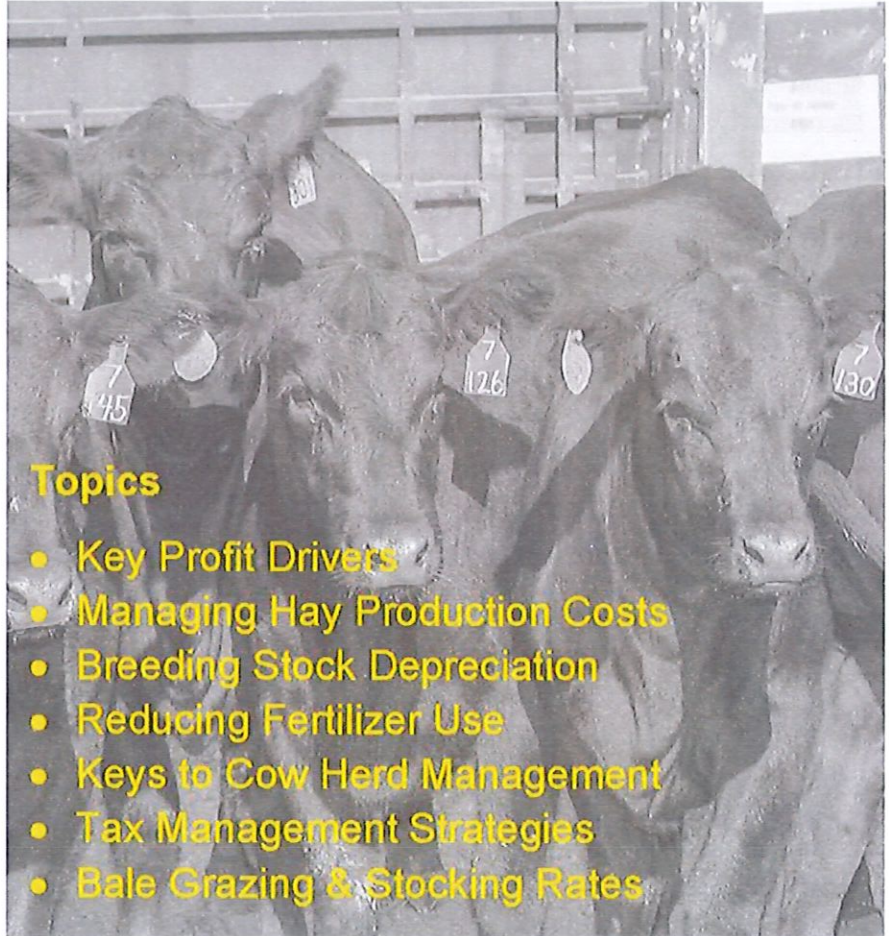
Cow-Calf Profitability Conference


